- India's Artificial Intelligence supercomputer Param Siddhi has achieved 63rd rank among top 500 most powerful non-distributed computer systems in the world.
- Several packages developed under the National Supercomputing Mission for drug design and preventive health care system, flood-forecasting package for flood prone metro cities like Mumbai, Delhi, Chennai, Patna and Guwahati.
- This will help in further research & development to battle against COVID-19 through faster simulations, medical imaging, genome sequencing and forecasting.

- The middle segment of the world's third-largest solid propellant rocket booster 'S-200 was produced at L&T's Powai Aerospace Manufacturing Facility in Mumbai.

Arunachal Pradesh records best sex ratio in India, Manipur the worst

- A 2018 report on the 'vital statistics on India based on the Civil Registration System' has revealed that Arunachal Pradesh records the best sex ratio in the country while Manipur records the worst.
- The Office of the Registrar General & Census Commissioner released the report.
- Sex ratio at birth is number of females born per thousand males.
- Arunachal Pradesh recorded 1,084 females born per thousand males, followed by Nagaland (965) Mizoram (964) and Kerala (963), while Manipur (757) recorded the worst.
- The number of registered births increased to 2.33 crore in 2018 from 2.21 crore registered births the previous year.
- The level of registration of births has increased to 89.3% in 2018 from 81.3% in 2009.
