#### **Tamil Nadu becomes first State to enact law on contract farming**

- Tamil Nadu has become the first State in the country to enact a law on contract farming with President Ram Nath Kovind giving assent to the Agricultural Produce and Livestock Contract Farming and Services (Promotion and Facilitation) Act.
- The law would safeguard the interests of farmers when there is a bumper crop or during major fluctuation in market prices. In such a scenario, the farmers will be paid a predetermined price arrived at the time of signing agreements with buyers.

#### **IIIT Hyderabad researchers create first ever Indian Brain atlas**

- Researchers at the IIIT Hyderabad that the first ever Indian Brain Atlas (IBA) has been created.
- They stated that the next step is to prepare atlases for different age groups to study age related effects on brain anatomy.
- The average brain size of an Indian was smaller in height, width and volume in comparison to people of the Caucasian and eastern races.
- The immediate implication of this finding can be seen in treatment outcomes of neurological problems or brain related ailments - like dementia, Alzheimer's disease, Parkinson's disease etc.

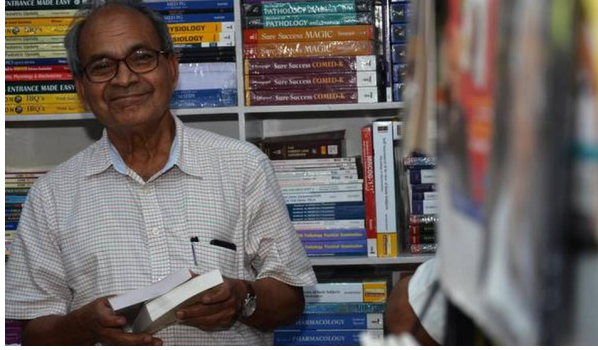
**Lebanon PM Saad Hariri resigns amid nationwide anti-government protests**

### Sadako Ogata: First female UN refugee chief dies at 92



- A Japanese academic and diplomat who became the first female to be appointed UN High Commissioner for Refugees has died aged 92.
- Sadako Ogata worked on some of the largest crises of the decade during her time in service from 1991 to 2000.
- Challenges included helping Kurdish refugees fleeing from Iraq after the 1991 Gulf War, and the Balkans War.
- She was known for her great passion in working to protect the "defenceless and dispossessed".

### Shiva Thapa, Pooja Rani win gold at Olympic Test event for Boxing

- Shiva Thapa (63kg) and Pooja Rani (75kg) clinched gold medals with impressive wins, while Ashish (69kg) settled for a silver as India ended with a decent haul of seven medals at the Olympic Test Event for Boxing.

### Rugby World Cup: South Africa crowned champions as England fall short

- South Africa have won the Rugby World Cup in a stunning 32-12 victory over Eddie Jones's England.
- The Springboks are champions for a third time after Makazole Mapimpi and Cheslin Kolbe added tries to Handré Pollard's 22 kicked points.
- A strong performance from Rassie Erasmus's side was too much for England but the consistency of the boot of fly-half Pollard made the difference

### Pooja lights up day for India at Worlds with bronze medal

- Pooja Dhanda became only the fourth Indian woman grappler to win a medal at the World Championship, grabbing a bronze with a stunning 10-7 win over the 2017 European champion Grace Jacob Bullen.
- One of the two wrestlers in a medal contention, the 24-year-old Pooja executed a four-point throw in each of the two periods in the 57kg contest to deliver the best performance of her career.

### Korea Junior Open Badminton: Luwang wins boys' title; Sathish wins bronze



- Maisnam Meiraba Luwang lived up to his top billing as he clinched the boys' singles U-19 title at the Woncheon Yonex Korea Junior Open International Challenge 2019 in Miryang, Korea.

- The top seed from Manipur needed just 36 minutes to brush aside the challenge of 15th seed Lee Hak Joo of Korea in a 21-10, 21-13 win.
