National Fertilizers Limited to set up an Organic Waste Converter Plant

- National Fertilizers Limited, NFL, a PSU under the Department of Fertilizers is going to set up an Organic Waste Converter, OWC Plant in Vijaipur, Madhya Pradesh.
- The project is an initiative towards Swachh Bharat Mission; aims to recycle around 2000 Kg per day of the biodegradable waste generated in township including the horticulture waste and convert it into compost.
- The biodegradable waste collected in the unit will be transported to OWC where it will be segregated from non-degradable parts.
- The unit plans to utilize the compost as manure in various outdoor works around the community.

National Commission on Population has Projected India's Population to be More Feminine by 2036

- The National Commission on Population under the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (MoHFW) submitted the Report on population projections July 2020, titled "Population projections for India and States 2011- 2036".
- The report projected that the India's sex ratio of the total population is expected to be more feminine in 2036 compared to the population as of 2011.
- The report projects India's population to increase by 25.7% in 25 years at a rate of 1% annually i.e., from 121.1 crore to 151.8 crore during 2011-36.

• The report also estimated that the population growth rate would decline by 8.4% during 2021-2031.

- Aramco decided to stop investing in the facility in China's Northeastern province of Liaoning due to uncertain market outlook.
