India to support airport expansion project in Maldives

- India is set to support the expansion of Hanimaadhoo International Airport located in the northern part of the Maldives.
- The project work is expected to begin next year and will involve extending the runway to 2,200m, as well as the modernisation of terminals, fuel farms, cargo terminal and fire station.
- The runway extension will enable larger aircraft such as Airbus A320s and Boeing 737s to land at the airport.
- Earlier, India extended an \$800m line of credit through EXIM Bank for several infrastructure projects in the Maldives. This credit line is also expected to support the Hanimaadhoo Airport expansion.

- Former Atomic Energy Commission Chairman and Secretary to the Govt. of India, Dr. Sekhar Basu passed away this morning (24 September 2020) at a hospital in Kolkata.
- Dr. Basu was Secretary to the Government of India, Department of Atomic Energy (DAE) from October 2015 to September 2018.
- Prior to his assumption of charge as Secretary, DAE, he was holding the position of Director, Bhabha Atomic Research Centre (BARC) from June 2012 to October 2015.
- He played a key role in obtaining government approvals for 10 Pressurized Heavy Water Reactors (PHWRs) and Two Pressurized Water Reactors (PWRs).
