#### FIH unveils new world ranking system for 2020

- The International Hockey Federation (FIH) unveiled a new world ranking system for 2020 in Lausanne, Switzerland.
- It will come into effect from the first of next month. For a better reflection of current performances, the new ranking will be match-based instead of tournament-based calculation.
- The new world ranking system has been launched after 12 months of painstaking research, analysis and testing.
- It cited numerous restrictions of the tournament-based system for the change.
- The world body governing hockey also said that the new model removes much of the subjectivity surrounding continental weighing by creating a system which is fair to all.
