NATIONAL NEWS

MP Government to Launch CM Learn and Earn Scheme

- In Madhya Pradesh, the Chief Minister's Learn and Earn scheme is set to be launched with the aim of providing employable skills to the youth.
- Chief Minister's Learn and Earn scheme in Madhya Pradesh focuses on providing training, financial support, and employment opportunities to the youth.
- By identifying numerous work areas and involving various industries, the scheme aims to equip the young workforce with the necessary skills to enhance their employability and contribute to the state's development.
- A significant aspect of the Learn and Earn scheme is that it not only focuses on skill acquisition but also provides financial support to the youth.
- Participants in the scheme will receive a monthly allowance ranging from Rs 8,000 to 10,000.
- This allowance aims to assist the youth in meeting their financial needs while they learn and work.
- The Learn and Earn scheme is a proactive measure taken by the government to address the issue of unemployment by equipping young individuals with necessary skills.

NHPC Inks MoU with Maharashtra Government

- State-owned NHPC Limited has announced its collaboration with the Department of Energy, Maharashtra government through a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU).
- The primary objective of this partnership is to establish Energy Storage Systems, specifically Pumped Storage Systems, alongside other Renewable Energy Sources like Solar, Wind, and Hybrid, with a total combined capacity of 7,350 MW.
- The introduction of energy storage systems, such as Pumped Storage Systems, is crucial for storing excess energy during periods of low demand and utilizing it during peak hours.
- These systems play a vital role in ensuring a reliable and uninterrupted power supply.
- They contribute to grid stability, enable efficient energy management, and facilitate the integration of intermittent renewable energy sources into the power grid.
- By combining pumped storage systems with solar, wind, and hybrid power generation, this collaboration aims to optimize the utilization of renewable energy resources.

First AIIMS in Country to Get NABH Accreditation

- AIIMS Nagpur, the branch of the All-India Institute of Medical Sciences in Nagpur, has emerged as the first AIIMS in India to be accredited by the National Accreditation Board for Hospitals (NABH).
- This accreditation places AIIMS Nagpur at par with the world's leading hospital standards in terms of quality and patient care.

- The NABH accreditation serves as validation of their efforts in these fields.
- The NABH accreditation is a voluntary and internationally recognized certification that signifies a healthcare organization's commitment to delivering high-quality healthcare services and ensuring patient safety.

KFON Internet Connectivity Launched by Kerala Government

- The Pinarayi Vijayan-led Kerala government officially launched the Kerala Fiber Optical Network (KFON).
- Kerala is the first state to declare the right to internet as a fundamental right.
- The main objective of KFON is to bridge the digital divide and ensure high-speed broadband internet access to all households and government offices in Kerala.
- KFON uses fibre optic technology to provide fast and reliable internet connection.
- The Government of Kerala aims to bridge the digital divide and promote digital inclusion through the implementation of KFON.
- The initiative aims to create a robust digital infrastructure that fosters innovation, economic growth and social development.

INTERNATIONAL NEWS

Non-Permanent Members of The UN Security Council

- Algeria, Guyana, the Republic of Korea, Sierra Leone and Slovenia were elected nonpermanent members of the UN Security Council for a two-year term.
- The newly elected members will take up their new responsibilities on 01 January 2024 and serve till 31 December 2025.
- Slovenia defeated Belarus by a vote of 153 to 38, while Algeria, Guyana, Sierra Leone and the Republic of Korea were elected unopposed.
- These new members will replace Albania, Brazil, Gabon, Ghana and the United Arab Emirates at present when their two-year term ends on 31 December 2023.
- It was established in 1945 by the United Nations Charter.

- India's total medal tally has gone up to nine at the Under-20 Asian Athletics Championships in South Korea.

Veteran Hindi and Marathi film Actress Sulochana Latkar

- Latkar was a recipient of the civilian honour of Padma Shri in 1999 for her contribution to cinema.
- In 2003, she was awarded the Chitrabhushan Award instituted by the Akhil Bharatiya Marathi Chitrapat Mahamandal.
- She was awarded the Filmfare Lifetime Achievement Award in 2004.
