 - Coastal routes for urban transportation covering the entire coastline of India
 - Various technologies like AI, Big Data, Geo Fencing, IOT based truck platooning, GIS based cargo tracking etc. were discussed to simplify and to convert Major Ports into 'Smart Ports' and further 'Intelligent Ports' as envisioned in Maritime India Vision-2030.

INTERNATIONAL NEWS

India- Bangladesh hold Joint Steering Committee meeting on power sector

- Nineteenth meeting of the Joint Steering Committee on India Bangladesh cooperation in the energy sector was held in Dhaka on January 24, 2021.
- The steering committee took stock of the progress of implementation of the decisions taken during the last meeting of the Joint Working Group (JWG) and Joint Steering Committee (JSC).
- India and Bangladesh have set up the institutional mechanism of JSC and JWG for reviewing and enhancing bilateral cooperation in the power sector between the two countries.
- The last meetings were held in March 2020 in Udaipur in India.

Ex Desert Knight 2021

- The Indian Air Force and French Air and Space Force participated in Ex Desert Knight 2021 at Air Force Station Jodhpur.
- Ex Desert Knight 2021 is the bilateral Air exercise between India and France. The 2021 is the first edition of the exercise
- Rafale aircraft from both sides along with Su-30 MKI and Mirage 2000 aircraft of the IAF undertook complex missions including Large Force Engagements.

- Both Air Forces exercised in realistic settings with an aim to enhance operational capabilities and interoperability.
- The exercise provided an opportunity to share best practices and evolve operational concepts; particularly for effective combat employment of the Rafale fleet.
