7th "Community Radio Sammelan" to be held in Delhi from Aug 27-29

- The seventh "**Community Radio Sammelan**" will be held here from August 27-29 during which representatives of community radio stations will discuss experiences and possibilities of programming for raising awareness on sustainable development goals in a better manner.
- The "**Sammelan**", being organised at **Dr B R Ambedkar Bhawan** by the Ministry of Information and Broadcasting, will also witness discussion on various flagship schemes of the government such as the Jal Shakti Abhiyaan and efforts for disaster risk reduction.
- The theme of this year's Sammelan is "**Community Radio for SDGs**".

- The stadium, however, will also continue to be known by its geographical location, the Feroz Shah Kotla, after the 14th century monument which is situated next to it.

Microsoft to train 5000 govt employees on AI, cloud
