


Inauguration of Hypersonic Wind Tunnel at DRDO Hyderabad

Inauguration of Hypersonic Wind Tunnel at DRDO Hyderabad



- Union Minister Rajnath Singh inaugurated the Hypersonic Winf Tunnel testing facility in the DRDO, Hyderabad.
- The state-of-the-art HWT Test facility is pressure vacuum driven enclosed free jet facility having nozzle exit diameter of 1 meter and will simulate Mach No 5 to 12.
- This indigenously developed technology made India is the third country to have such a large facility in terms of size and operating capability to simulate hypersonic flow over a wide spectrum and will play a major role in the realization of highly complex futuristic aerospace and defence systems.
