## PM to Address the Grand Challenges Annual Meet 2020

- Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi will deliver the keynote address at the inaugural function of Grand Challenges Annual Meeting 2020, on 19th October
- The Grand Challenges Annual Meeting, for the last 15 years, has fostered international innovation collaborations to address the biggest challenges in health and development
- Grand Challenges India was set up as a partnership of the Department of Biotechnology, Government of India and the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation in 2012
- The meeting is co-hosted by Grand Challenges India and Grand Challenges Canada, Ministry of Science and Technology, ICMR, NITI Aayog, US Agency for International Development and Wellcome.

## BrahMos successfully test fired from Indian Navy's INS Chennai

- BRAHMOS, the supersonic cruise missile was successfully test fired today from Indian Navy's indigenously-built stealth destroyer INS Chennai
- BRAHMOS as a prime strike weapon will ensure the warship's invincibility by engaging naval surface targets at long ranges, thus making the destroyer another lethal platform of Indian Navy
- The highly versatile BRAHMOS has been jointly designed, developed and produced by India and Russia.

## India-Sri Lanka Bilateral Maritime Exercise

- The Eighth Edition of annual Indian Navy Sri Lanka bilateral maritime exercise SLINEX will be carried out in Trincomalee, Sri Lanka from 19 to 21 October 2020
- Indigenously built ASW corvettes Kamorta and Kilta will be participating in the exercise along with Indian Navy Advanced Light Helicopter (ALH) and Chetak helicopter embarked onboard IN ships, and Dornier Maritime Patrol Aircraft
- SLINEX-20 aims to enhance inter-operability, improve mutual understanding and exchange best practices and procedures for multi-faceted maritime operations between both navies.

• The previous edition of SLINEX was conducted off Visakhapatnam in September 2019.
