India out from Developing countries list: USTR.

- The United States Trade Representatives(USTR) takes off India from the developing countries list.
- While amending the list of developing, least developed countries eligible for better treatment with respect to **Countervailing Duties(CVDs)** investigation.
- The amendment has come to make it easier for the US government to impose the CVDs on goods from India and certain other nations.
- Along with India, **Brazil, Indonesia, Malaysia, Thailand, Vietnam** were also taken off from the list.
