Noble Prize for Physics

• The Royal Swedish Academy of Sciences decided to award one half of the 2020 Nobel Prize in

physics to Roger Penrose and the other half jointly to Reinhard Genzel and Andrea Ghez for furthering the understanding of black holes.

- Penrose has been awarded the prize for the discovery "that black hole formation is a robust prediction of the general theory of relativity,".
- Genzel and Ghez have been awarded the prize for the discovery of a "supermassive compact object at the centre of our galaxy."

APPOINTMENTS:

Dinesh Khara appointed as SBI chairman

- The centre has appointed Dinesh Khara as the new Chairman of State Bank of India (SBI) for a tenure of three years.
- He has been one of the four managing directors of SBI, replacing Rajnish Kumar the former chairman.
