UP Signs Agreement with Israel for Water Resource Management in Bundelkhand

- The government of Uttar Pradesh (UP) with the Israel's Water Resource Minister signed an agreement for the water resource management in Bundelkhand region in Uttar Pradesh.
- Ron Malka, Israel's Ambassador to India and Alok Sinha, Agriculture Production Commissioner of Uttar Pradesh signed the 'plan of cooperation' on behalf of Israel and India respectively.
- The 'plan of cooperation' is initially signed for 2 years.
