India contributed USD 15.46 mn to India-UN Development Partnership Fund of UNOSSC

- India has contributed **USD 15.46 million** to the India-UN (United Nations) Development Partnership Fund as a support to fellow developing nations for their **2030 Agenda** for Sustainable Development and related projects.
- Out of USD 15.46 mn, USD 6 million is contributed to the overall fund, in which all the developing countries are eligible for partnership, and USD 9.46 million dedicated to the Commonwealth countries.
- An amount of **USD 15.46 million** handed over by India's Permanent Representative to the UN **Ambassador T S Tirumurti** to the **United Nations Office for South-South Cooperation (UNOSSC)**.
