Naval Air Enclave & CIAL inks MoU for air operations

 Operation "Number Plate" to identify and verify all vehicles parked in Railway premises,
 circulating area, parkings and even in the 'No Parking' areas for longer duration.
- The unidentified vehicles are considered as a serious threat to security and safety of passengers and other stake holders of railways.
- It has been conducted specifically in view of forthcoming celebrations of Independence Day on 15th August 2019.

Budget scheme for liquidity support to NBFCs rolls out

- India has operationalised a partial guarantee scheme announced in the budget for non-banking and housing finance companies (NBFCs and HFCs), which will allow state-run banks (PSBs) to purchase their assets.
- It is aimed at providing liquidity support to avoid distress sale of assets in a sector facing a shortage of cash due to asset-liability mismatch.

• The stress on NBFCs and HFCs is seen as a key reason for a slowdown in the economy, as it has caused reduced credit flow to small businesses and consumers.
