Status of Leopards report released



- The Status of Leopards in India 2018 was released by the Minister for Environment, Forest and Climate Change.
- Leopards are the vulnerable species in the IUCN Red list.
- The observations based on this report are:
 - Total strength of leopards in India has increased 60% in population to 12852 compared to 7910 in 2014.
 - Madhya Pradesh ranks first in the population of leopard with a strength of 3,421 followed by Karnataka (1,783) and (Maharashtra at 1,690)

- The MoA aids for use of advanced heliborne geophysical survey and other scientific studies in parts of the States of Rajasthan, Gujarat and Haryana under the Aquifer Mapping Programme.
- This is the first time Ministry of Jal Shakti has decided to use the state of the art technology for identification of aquifers in such a large arid/semi-arid area of the country.

- Following key areas are covered in the Electricity (Rights of consumers) Rules:
 - Rights of consumers and Obligations of Distribution licensees
 - Release of new connection and modification in existing connection
 - Metering arrangement
 - Billing and Payment
 - Disconnection and Reconnection
 - Reliability of supply
 - Consumer as Prosumer
 - Standards of Performance of licensee
 - Compensation Mechanism
 - Call Centre for Consumer Services
 - Grievance redressal mechanism

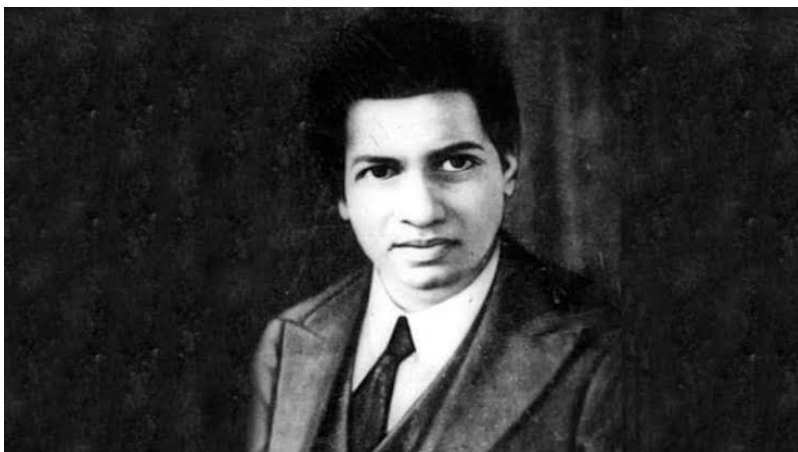

- According to the report India has dropped two ranks on the Human Development Index (HDI) to 131 among the 189 countries ranked.
- HDI is calculated as the Geometric Mean of life expectancy, education, and GNI per capita of a nation.
- Norway ranks first in HDI while Niger is place in the 189th rank.
