  - Eleven awards will be conferred under the category of Best Media Coverage of Yoga in Newspapers, Eight under the category "Best Media Coverage of Yoga in Television while 11 awards to be conferred under the category "Best Media Coverage of Yoga in Radio. The award will consist of a special medal, plaque, trophy and a citation.

• The Defence Expo 2020 will be held for the first time in Lucknow from February 5 to 9. It will be the biggest ever defence exhibition in the country in terms of participation of exhibitors, the area of the exhibition and the revenue to be earned. Prime Minister Narendra Modi will inaugurate the exhibition.
